

## Calling All Hohenlohe Pork Butcher Descendants

### Project: Anglo/German Recipe Book

Over the years, I have collected two dual language recipe books that I really enjoy using. With the help of Karl-Heinz and Hannelore Wüstner I would like to collect recipes from Hohenlohe, as eaten by our forefathers, both in Württemberg and when they arrived in Britain. Many married women from Hohenlohe, others married local women here in UK. Bringing these recipes together in a book with a note about family, place of origin and migration destination will, through food, paint a picture of the collective lives of our pork butcher ancestors.

The recipe book is intended as a charitable project with the only costs being those of printing and any profits from sales benefitting the Anglo German Family History Society, or a similar charity.

Carol Hunt has kindly provided me with a recipe from her Hohenlohe grandmother, and I have added a recipe from my family. They are in English and German with information about the families. I have attached them in a file with this email.

**To collect the recipes, I need your help and I hope that many of you will be able to find out contribute your family recipes.**

Please can you send me any recipes in either English or German. The recipes may be:

- soups, stews, meats, sausages, offal, fish, vegetables, breads, cakes, pastries, drinks, or medicinal remedies.
- in imperial measures, or metric, or cups, or proportions (e.g. twice the amount of butter to flour). The recipes will be converted to metric, where necessary, and tested and photographed.
- from families leaving Hohenlohe
- from the British family a Hohenlohe pork butcher married into.

With each recipe please provide:

- Name of the family
- Hohenlohe village/hamlet/town and/or the English town they emigrated to
- When they emigrated.

**Time frame:** It would be good to have this ready for sale in November. Hopefully, it will make an attractive Christmas present, easily sent through the post to friends and family. To achieve a November 'launch' date I will need to have recipes by **30<sup>th</sup> April 2017**.
